TRAINING WENILOSEBA ON PROPOSAL WRITING BY CONSULTANT

Main Objective

To organize training by consultant on Strategic and business plan and proposal writing skills

- Improve Associations' technical skills in proposal writing
- Enable Associations come up with proposal draft to be submitted for funding.
- Enable WENILOSEBA & NULSBA come up with a strategic business plan for the association
- Improve associations' knowledge in professional writing
- Build association capacity in Business plan development

Methodology

A consultant will train NULSBA and WENILOSEBA's technical staff and four (04) members from each of the executive on strategic and business plan and proposal writing.

This training will take a total of eight(8days) four (04) days for each association. The first three (03) days will be for proposal development and the fourth day will be for reviewing the proposal.

This training is tentatively scheduled for September 2019.

Expected Outcome

The associations capacity built in areas of strategic plan development, business plan development and proposal writing skills.

The associations will be able to write proposals in order to win grants, donations and other financial assistance to support in growing the association and also in running its activities.
